Kumiko Workshop

Kumiko is a traditional Japanese technique of using interlocking wooden strips to make beautiful lattice work. These can be used on lamps, door panels or gift boxes for decoration

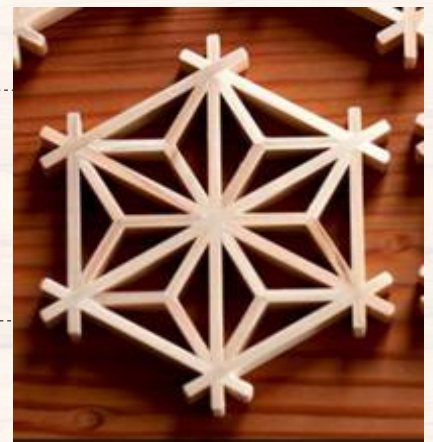

Kumiko Details

3 steps to make Kumiko

1. Make Sticks of uniform thickness
2. Cut slots in Sticks for square/triangle grid
3. Make infill pieces to create the design you want

Setup needed to continue at home

1. Japanese Pull saw with fine teeth (about Rs 2500) or a fine toothed jeweller's saw, a 12 mm chisel (Rs 200)
2. block plane (Rs 350/-)
3. portable bench vice (Rs 1700/-)
4. Kumiko Jigs Kit (Rs 1500/-)
 - a. jigs for making infill pieces
22.5, 45, 67.5, 30, 60.
 - b. Bench Hook
 - c. Thickness jig
 - d. Sharpening setup

Getting Kumiko sticks after the workshop:

You can order the sticks for required grid (square / triangular) and design which can be shipped to you thru a local courier. Costing will depend on size and complexity of the design required.

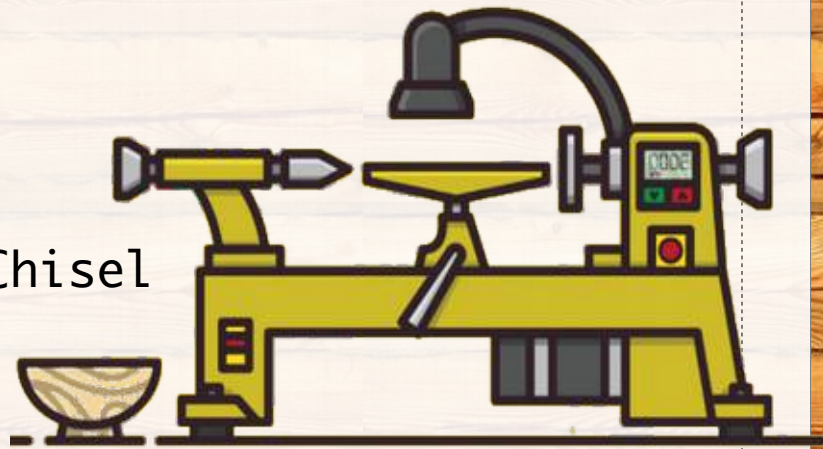

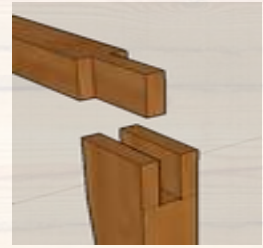
